John 6:1-71

### ***Jesus, the Bread of Life:***

#### **FEEDS**

6: 1-21

- \*Looking at the crowd, Jesus saw their need for physical food, as well as \_\_\_\_\_ food.
- \*The disciples looked at the facts and decided it was impossible to feed the large crowd.
- \*Jesus took what was offered, gave thanks to His Heavenly Father, and fed the crowd.
- \*The disciples gathered \_\_\_\_\_ of leftovers.
- \*Jesus performed three miracles on the Sea of Galilee:
  1. He walked on \_\_\_\_\_.
  2. He calmed the storm.
  3. Instantly the boat was at the shore.

***When you trust Jesus, the Bread of Life, to meet your physical needs, He feeds your faith and leads you into a deeper relationship with Him.***

#### **SATISFIES**

6: 22-50

- \*The crowd witnessed one of Jesus' greatest miracles and still demanded more evidence.
- \*Jesus reveals two major truths:
  1. It was God the Father, not Moses, who gave the Israelites the bread from heaven.
  2. The Father now gives us \_\_\_\_\_, the true Bread from heaven.
- \*Physical bread gives temporary satisfaction, but the true Bread of Life satisfies eternally.
- \*The Father's will is this: whoever looks to Jesus and believes will receive eternal life.

***Place your trust in Jesus, the Bread of Life, who is able to eternally satisfy all your cravings.***

#### **SAVES**

6: 51-71

- \* Eating the body of Jesus and drinking His blood implies \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus.
- \* Because of unbelief, many in the crowd turned away from following Jesus.
- \* The Twelve Apostles were confused, but they chose to stay by Jesus' side.
- \* Peter understood the divine order of believing **then** \_\_\_\_\_.

**JESUS the WORD – John 6:1-71**

**1 PETER 1:24-25a** [F]or, “All flesh is like grass and all its glory like the flower of grass. The grass withers and the flower falls, but the word of the Lord remains forever.”

**MATTHEW 14:15-16** Now when it was evening, the disciples came to him and said, “This is a desolate place, and the day is now over; send the crowds away to go into the villages and buy food for themselves.” But Jesus said, “They need not go away; you give them something to eat.”

**PHILIPPIANS 2:14-15** Do all things without grumbling or disputing, that you may be blameless and innocent, children of God without blemish in the midst of a crooked and twisted generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world.

**MATTHEW 14:22** Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds.

**HEBREWS 11:1** Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
