Role's Mission:

The Nursery Director partners with the Children's Minister- Fort Worth Campus and the Children's Minister to be the architect, implementer, champion and multi-site liaison of the Next Generation Nursery program.

- As *Architect* you evaluate the Nursery program and Parent Dedication, consult with the Children's Minister – Fort Worth and implement needed changes.
- As *Implementer* you recruit, train, develop and oversee an effective team of front-line volunteers at the Fort Worth Campus to execute a safe, fun and evangelistic children's program.
- As *Champion* you inspire, recruit, and motivate volunteers
- As *Multisite Liaison* you will lead the effort and team with the staff person overseeing Nursery at our multi-site(s) to develop training for classes with children who are 2 years old and younger. You will also serve as the administrative contact for Parent Dedication for all campuses. You will team with the staff person overseeing Nursery at our multi-site(s) to share ideas, collaborate and maintain consistency between campuses.

Role's Relationship:

The Nursery Director- Fort Worth Campus reports directly to the Children's Minister – Fort Worth Campus.

Role's Requirements:

Character-

- Must be a maturing believer who is obviously, consistently and increasingly manifesting the fruit of the Spirit in his daily walk with Christ (Galatians 5:22-23) as well as among others
- Must be living an "above reproach" lifestyle as outlined in the Christ Chapel Employee Handbook

- Must be a faithful steward of work and time, with awareness that Christ Chapel employees are paid from the tithes and offerings of others

Calling-

- Must be committed to and supportive of the authority of the Elders, the pastoral staff, and the philosophy and direction of the church both in public and in private
- Must be able to articulate a specific and clear calling to ministry with children.

Competency-

- If a believer receives only one gift (1 Pet 4:10), then the ideal candidate has the spiritual gift of administration. (Rom 12; 1 Cor 12; Eph 4; 1 Pet 4)

Chemistry-

- Must be dependable, humble and approachable
- Must work well within a team environment
- Must have an optimistic, positive and cheerful demeanor.
- Must be able to receive direction and correction - a joy to supervise
- Must be flexible and adaptable
