- Must be able to multitask and work well in a team environment.

Preferences:

- The ideal candidate will have served in a student ministry role in a local church or in a student parachurch organization for three to five years with experience supervising and leading a paid staff to accomplish the work of the ministry
- The ideal candidate will have the spiritual gift of teaching and preaching
- The ideal candidate will have bachelor's degree from an accredited university with added preference of a master's degree from an accredited seminary
