Has God Rejected His People? No Way!

Paul is an illustration of this truth since he is an Israelite declared righteous by God's grace. Elijah's story is an example of a small group of Jews always remaining faithful to God. Even today, there is a remnant of Jewish believers chosen by grace and not by merit. The majority of Israelites had callused hearts that were insensitive to the truth of Jesus.

Has Israel Fallen Beyond Recovery? No Way!

When Israel rejected Jesus, the good news of salvation was sent to the Gentiles. The Gentiles were always included in God's plan and promise of salvation. God used the Gentiles to assure the future restoration of Israel. Paul uses two analogies for God's certain restoration of Israel.

- If the first fruit is holy, then the whole harvest is holy.
- If the root of the olive tree is holy, then the branches are holy.

Believing Jews will one day be grafted in again to the flourishing olive tree.

As believers, let your life of faith in Jesus ______ others to believe in Jesus.

Is Israel's Future Restoration Assured? Yes!

When the full number of believing Gentiles come into God's Kingdom, then Israel will be saved. The Jews rejected the gospel message, and the Gentiles benefited by their rejection of it. God's promise to Israel's patriarchs assures God will keep His promise of salvation for Israel. God's mercy is for all sinners, and we are all sinners!
