Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. – Colossians 1:28



# **Program Overview**

Actively participating in the life and body of Christ Chapel allows residents to be further equipped as ministry leaders by developing practical ministry skills, deepening biblical and theological knowledge and experiencing God-given growth in their character and passion for the gospel.

Residents contribute to and carry out essential ministry responsibilities alongside staff, engage in various meaningful, purposeful experiences and complete coursework through Dallas Theological Seminary as a part of their residency program. This is all aimed toward developing the skills, knowledge and maturity needed to lead in various contexts, whether vocational ministry, further seminary education, mission work or elsewhere.



The Christ Chapel Leadership Residency incorporates four academic courses accredited by Dallas Theological Seminary. After completing these courses on topics such as the study of Scripture, personal leadership, doctrines and disciplines, systematic theology and biblical hermeneutics, each resident will have obtained 12 credit hours by the end of the residency program.

### **Resident Development**

In addition to the residency program's academic component, Christ Chapel fosters each resident's growth in both ministry development and spiritual discipleship.

### MINISTRY DEVELOPMENT

- Individual guidance from dedicated ministry coaches
- Hands-on training, fostering a sense of ownership and developing direction
- Opportunities to observe, analyze and evaluate various aspects of ministry at Christ Chapel
- Responsibilities to engage with and oversee forward-facing ministry

#### SPIRITUAL DISCIPLESHIP

- Personalized shepherding and mentoring
- Ministry coaches train ongoingly to effectively disciple and mentor residents
- Guided integration of spiritual disciplines into daily routine
- Prioritization of spiritual growth above all else

# **Ministry Pathways**

Throughout the application process, residents are paired with one of fourteen unique ministry pathways, each with a dedicated coach, to engage with throughout the duration of the residency program. These ministry pathways are designed to develop and disciple residents through specific, semester goals. Pathways include:

Each 25-hour week includes 20 hours devoted to a resident's specific ministry pathway, with five hours reserved for residency classes.
