

CHRIST CHAPEL LEADERSHIP RESIDENCY

11 MONTHS + THEOLOGICAL TRAINING + CURATED MINISTRY EXPERIENCE

OVERVIEW

The Christ Chapel Leadership Residency offers 11 months of intentional development, blending hands-on ministry experience with personal spiritual growth to shape well-rounded, effective leaders.

As a Christ Chapel Leadership Resident, you will commit 25 hours a week to residency ministry which includes a specific ministry placement, residency classes, and spiritual mentoring. All residents are provided a \$1,500/monthly living stipend, a laptop for the duration of the program, and on-campus housing.

PURPOSE

The Christ Chapel Leadership Residency is designed to cultivate and equip future leaders. Over the course of the program, residents develop practical ministry skills, deepen their knowledge of Scripture and theology, and grow in character and passion for the gospel. Residents are integrated into the life of the church as full team members as they experience the many different approaches to ministry. Residents will contribute to and carry out essential ministry responsibilities alongside staff and engage in a variety of meaningful experiences.

OUTCOMES

Upon completing the Residency, graduates are equipped with Dallas Theological Seminary credit hours and the skills, knowledge, and spiritual maturity needed to lead in a variety of contexts. Whether pursuing vocational ministry, mission work, seminary education, or leadership roles at home or in the workplace, Christ Chapel Leadership Residency graduates are better prepared to serve and lead with confidence.

Who is the Christ Chapel Leadership Residency for?

The Christ Chapel Leadership Residency (CCLR) is for anyone interested in discovering what vocational ministry looks like. The program is a great way to experience ministry and theological education, while being intentionally developed.

What is my commitment to the program?

Your commitment to the CCLR is 25 hours a week, beginning June 1 and ending May 1. You will spend approximately 20 hours a week with your ministry team and five hours in residency classes.

What expenses will I have?

As a resident, you will be responsible for any books, curriculum, Dallas Theological Seminary fees, and housing utilities.

What ministry will I serve with?

As part of the application and interview process, you will select your top five ministry teams. Through the interviews, our staff will place you in the team that we believe is the best fit.
