

HSM Delight: Parent FAQs

We're excited to have your student join us for Delight! Below, you'll find answers to frequently asked questions covering everything from packing details and weekend expectations to safety policies and what your student can expect. Vision

As our first event of the fall semester, our hope is that Delight will be a meaningful time for students to connect, build friendships, and begin the semester surrounded by a community that encourages them. During the event, students will be placed in their fall semester small groups, helping them begin building relationships from the very beginning. Throughout the evening, students will enjoy teaching, worship, crafts, and a fun night of roller skating to close out the event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- **Where are we going?**

This year, all students will gather at our Fort Worth Campus, with check-in available at West and South Campus for students who call those campuses home. After check-in, we'll provide transportation to Fort Worth Campus to kick off the evening together. Around 9:45 P.M., we'll head to Rollerland West for a night of roller skating. At approximately 11 P.M., we'll transport students back to their respective campuses for pickup.

- **Who is going?**

Our HSM staff from all campuses, along with your student's fall semester small group leaders, will be at Delight. All leaders have been vetted and are excited to begin building relationships with students as they lead their small groups throughout the year.

- **How are students getting there?**

All students, staff, and leaders will travel together by bus or their own personal vehicle.

- **What are we doing during HSM Delight?**

Students will begin the evening with dinner at Fort Worth Campus, followed by a time of teaching and worship. From there, they'll enjoy a mix of structured activities and free time designed to help small groups connect. The evening will conclude with another teaching session, worship, and small group discussion before everyone heads to Rollerland West.

POLICIES & SAFETY

What is the cell phone policy?

Students are welcome to bring their phones to this one-night event, but we encourage them to set them aside during teaching, worship, and small group time so they can fully engage with one another and all that's planned for the evening. If you need to reach your student, you can contact one of our HSM staff members directly. Photos from the event will be shared with parents through our Waldo Photo Manager (details below).

What is the dress code?

Since we'll be doing crafts and roller skating throughout the evening, we encourage students to wear comfortable clothing that allows them to move freely. Although this is a girls-only event, we do ask that students dress modestly. Please avoid clothing that exposes the midriff. Thank you!

What is the medication policy?

Since students will only be with us for a few hours, we don't anticipate the need to administer medication during the event, with the exception of basic over-the-counter medications if needed. During registration, you'll have the opportunity to let our staff know if you prefer that your student not receive any over-the-counter medication.

Will there be a nurse?

Because Delight is a local, one-night event, we will not have a nurse on site. However, your student's safety is a top priority. Our HSM staff and trained adult leaders will be present throughout the evening to care for students and respond to any medical needs. If an emergency arises, we will contact emergency services immediately and notify you right away of any unforeseen issue or concern involving your student.

What is your safety policy regarding behavior and off-site travel?

For everyone's safety, any student caught with illegal substances, engaging in inappropriate behavior, or leaving any campus or Rollerland West without permission will be **sent home immediately**.

PHOTOS & COMMUNICATION

How do I get photos of my student during the trip?

We will have photos available through Waldo Photo Manager for all parents. Waldo is a facial recognition photo-sharing app that allows you to easily access photos from the event. You'll receive a QR code at check-in. After uploading a photo of your student, you'll receive text updates when new photos featuring your student are available. You'll then be able to download and share those photos directly.

What should my student bring?

Packing List:

- ✓ Bible, journal, and pen
- ✓ Refillable water bottle labeled with name
- ✓ Money for the snack shop at Rollerland West

Do NOT bring:

- ✗ Drugs/vapes/tobacco/alcohol
- ✗ Weapons, fireworks, or explosives
- ✗ Inappropriate clothing
